The gravity model for ex-post assessment of regional trade agreementsInitially used by Aitken (1973) as an ex-post assessment for the European Economic Community, the gravity model seems well defined for this issue for two reasons. There is general consensus among scholars, policy makers, and political leaders that the best way for African countries to develop is through regional trade.
